

SCOPE Citation and Plagiarism Specifications

SCOPE requires authors to use a reference format if their works contain other people's ideas or information, but will not restrict the types of reference formats.

However, if the author chooses to use a reference format other than APA, MLA and Chicago, please indicate in the submission email with a link to the details and information of that specific format.

The failure to use the reference format properly is PLAGIARISM., which is strictly prohibited by SCOPE administration team. If an author's work published on SCOPE contains content from others without citation, the author will bear the subsequent responsibility. SCOPE will not be responsible for the author's personal actions.
